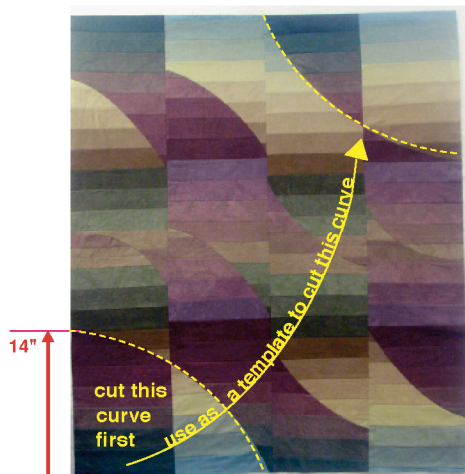

CORRECTION

for Optional Step 19



OPTIONAL

19a. With a chalk wheel, mark 14 inches from the corner on your first section. Using a sweeping motion, draw a curve with the chalk wheel between your mark and the seam allowance of your second section.

19b. Pressing down firmly, cut the curve with a rotary cutter. This is going to be bumpy because of all the seam allowances, but cut with confidence, so you don't make a jagged cut.

19c. Use this curve as a template to cut another curve out of the opposite corner, lining up the verticle seam.

19d. Exchange the two rounded corners and sew on to the quilt top using previous method.

19e. Trim the quilt top as necessary to make the edges even. You will loose some of the strips. And as you can see, my sections did not end up square. That's OK.
